



Brushed Gold PVD FAQs

What specific PVD process does the BGPVD undergo?

PVD stands for Physical Vapor Deposition. For Iver's Brushed Gold PVD finish, the solid brass hardware is firstly chrome plated, then placed in a vacuum chamber where the coating is deposited onto the hardware. A heat treatment process is then applied to bond the coating to the hardware.

Is BGPVD electroplated?

No – Electroplating is a different process to PVD. Electroplating may not possess the same level of hardness and wear resistance as PVD coatings.

How does PVD need to be cleaned?

Regular cleaning with a soft damp cloth will help maintain the integrity of the finish. Abrasives and chemicals should not be used on the finish.

How does this finish differ to a usual Brushed Brass?

Our Brushed Brass has a satin lacquer applied.

Will the finish only be in Brushed Gold?

Yes, for now we only offer PVD in Brushed Gold.

What are the key benefits of our PVD?

- Very long-lasting performance and durability
- High surface hardness
- Uniform coating
- UV stability
- Water based resistance: Suitability for coastal and moisture rich environments.
- Considerate of the environment – no chemicals or by products are created as the technique is carried out in a vacuum chamber and the metals evaporate after the process is completed.
